



The August book club is coming up quickly, on August 29th at 10:00 am. There's still time to read and join them! The book club is reading "Between the World and Me" by Ta-Nehisi Coates. The book, selected by Mary Ann Christenson, is a letter written from a father to his adolescent son. In this work, questions about American history and ideals and the background of our current crisis are addressed. What is it

like to inhabit a black body and find a way to live within it? This is what we learn as Ta-Nehisi shares the story of his awakening to the truth about his place in the world.

Some good news today: Polio is officially eradicated from Africa. The World Health Organization called it a "great day" for the world.

When I was a child, I remember summers staying at home because of the Polio Epidemic. We did not go to the circus and did not go to other public events. We stayed home.

When I was nineteen, I spent the Summer working as a Nurses' Aide at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor, working on the orthopedic ward with POST-POLIO patients.

Today, this virus, which was once common, and has no treatment or cure, is gone from Africa. There is Good News to Celebrate!
